All students pay regular tuition and a program fee. The program fee of the 2015 program is \$6,700. This fee covers housing costs (including utilities), the cost of U.K. instructors, the on-site British coordinator, library privileges at the Bodleian, associate membership at St. Anne's, ABA fees and other administrative expenses. Food, transportation, and other personal expenses are not included. A required deposit fee of \$250 will be assessed after you have accepted admission to the program. One hundred dollars (\$100) of this deposit is refundable if you have been accepted to the program and withdraw from the program by August 19, 2014. A second deposit of \$1,000 is due by September 1, 2014. The balance of the program fee will be due in December 2014. Amounts paid in addition to the \$250 are not refundable, except in emergency situations. The University of Georgia School of Law reserves the right to cancel this program in the event of compelling circumstances. All monies, including the \$250 deposit, would in such event be returned within twenty (20) days of the date of cancellation and the law school will make its best efforts to arrange for the student to attend a similar program, if the student wishes, and to the extent feasible.
