However, the seminar component (2 hours once a week, with readings, journals, interviews with Prof. Scherr, two papers), was painful. The readings are complete fluff, and class discussions were boring and useless. Thus, writing papers (what Prof. Scherr would call the "reflective" aspect of the clinic experience) was incredibly soul-sucking. My placement was in Atlanta, and you have to be on-site 10 hours a week between the time spent in class, preparing for class, driving to and from Atlanta, and actually being at my placement, the Clinic took up (easily) 20 hours a week.
