Training Courses Created

- Created *Advanced ChildFirst, Georgia: Your Role in the Judicial Process*, a 3-day course taught by a faculty consisting of prosecutors, forensic interviewers, licensed professional counselors, licensed child psychologists, and law enforcement officers and combining classroom lectures with courtroom exercises designed to train teams of interdisciplinary child abuse professionals how to investigate, prosecute, and testify in child sexual abuse cases (2007)
 - This 3-day course utilizes a mock child sexual abuse scenario with a complete case file and walks participants through the child’s disclosure of sexual abuse, the child’s forensic interview, the post-disclosure investigation by law enforcement, the multi-disciplinary team (MDT) meeting, the prosecutor’s assessment and charging decision, the prosecutor’s pretrial motion practice and trial preparation, and culminates in a mock trial in which the participants are subjected to direct and cross-examination by volunteer prosecutors after which they are critiqued by the faculty.
